- Started honors in 2003
- Minimum 3.25 GPA
- Complete 24 Honors Hours by Graduation
- All Honors Students Take Honors Seminar
- Honors Students Have the Option to Live in the Honors Hall
- Honors Students From All Over the U.S. and Other Countries
- Take Trips to Present Work and Research
- Receive a \$600/year Stipend
- Receive Special Recognition at Graduation
- 168 undergraduate students enrolled

University of Arkansas

- Started Honors in 1954
- Honors hours requirements based on college of major
- Most of the hours must be related to major
- Most of the colleges require an undergraduate thesis/ project
- Must attend seminars (Ex. Cancer, Prosecution, etc.)
- 3,000 undergraduate students enrolled
- ACT 28+ / SAT 1240(Pre-March 2016), 1310(Post-March 2016)
- Minimum GPA 3.5
- Honors Students live in a Honors Hall

Arkansas State University

- Reinstated honors program in the 80s
- ► ACT 28+
- Minimum GPA 3.5
- Living Learning Community
- Research Opportunities (Not required)
- Take Spring Break trips
- Receive a Honors cord at graduation

University of Central Arkansas

- Started Honors in 1982
- All students required to take a Honors Seminar course
- ► Minimum GPA 3.5
- Require Two essays with application
- Must complete 15 honors hours
- Honors Students live in their own hall
