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HOW TO WRITE

Create A Draft

- Know your audience
- Create a list of ideas that will be included in the essay that go along with the assigned topic
- Begin writing the essay using an introduction.
 Then build upon that with body paragraphs, and end with a conclusion. This becomes your rough draft.

Revising and Editing

- Read over the essay and check for these things:
 - Style
 - Grammar
 - Spelling (Spell check)
 - Other ideas to add
- Get a friend to look over the essay. Peers can help get a new perspective and see things that may have been missed.
- Avoid using these:
 - Text Language (LOL, LMAO, UR)
 - Emoticons

Final Copy

- Should have:
 - Introduction, Body Paragraphs, and Conclusion
 - Proper grammar
 - Correct sentence structure
 - Thoughtful ideas
 - Analysis
 - Correct Spelling
