ublic Universities

- Government funded
- Typically larger than most private universities
- Relatively high acceptance rates





uthern Arkansas University

rivate Universities

- Can be for profit or non-profit
- Receive little or no government funding
- Include some of the most prestigious universities in the country
- Sometimes has religious affiliation
- Stricter admission policies



nderbilt University

ommunity Colleges

- Offer two-year degrees
- Often a cheaper alternative to complete core courses before transferring to a university



illips Community College

iberal Arts Colleges

- Majority of students are undergraduate
- Mostly offer four-year degrees
- Skill focus is broad rather than preprofessional
- Typically smaller than public or private universities



ashington and Lee University

egionally Accredited Universities

- Credits are widely accepted and transferrable
- Accredited by regional agencies
- Acknowledged as functioning toward particular goals

ationally Accredited Universities

- Generally focus on career or religious education
- Credits are not as reliably transferrable

ender-specific universities

- Female-only universities more common than male-only universities
- Four male universities as compared to about 35 female universities
