


# How to Write (an essay)

# Intro

The introduction should be designed to attract the reader's attention and give the reader an idea of the essay's focus – like a roadmap to the rest of your paper



# I. Attention Grabber - HOOK

The attention grabber you use is up to you, but here are some ideas:

- Startling Information (must be true)
- Anecdote
- Dialogue
- Summary Information



## 2. Introduce topic

This part is used to add one or two more sentences that will lead the reader from your opening line to your thesis statement.

# 3. Thesis

- THE MAIN STATEMENT OF YOUR PAPER -

The thesis statement is developed, supported, and explained in the course of your paper by means of examples and evidence by each of the main points.

# Body Paragraph

At this point you should go into detail with context of the main argument you're trying to make by using the main points as discussed in the thesis.

# I. Topic Sentence

Reiterate each of the main points from the thesis statement and the ideas that follow those points to start each body paragraph.

## 2. Context of the Argument

This is where you will implement the background info / framework of the main points and how they are at all relative to the argument being made in the essay.

## 3. Closing Statement

The last sentence of each body paragraph should bring the main point being discussed to a successful negotiated stance of your take on the argument with the readers in mind to a settling / closing point.

# Conclusion

The conclusion brings closure to the reader, summing up your points or providing a final perspective on your topic.

Wholly the conclusion only needs three or four strong sentences which do not necessarily need to follow any set formula – unlike the rest of the essay.

# Recap of the main idea / point

Simply review the main points (being careful not to restate them exactly) or briefly describe your feelings about the topic. Even an anecdote can bring your essay closer to the end in a useful way!

# Repeat Thesis

Again, do NOT repeat the thesis in the same way! Perhaps relay the thesis once more in a way that inclines positively toward your view of the argument being made in your essay!
