# THE BASICS

- Located within Universities
- Part of a larger Undergraduate Program
- Larger and More Diverse Than Honors Program
- Typically lead by a Dean
- Often Require a Senior Thesis or Project
- Typically Larger Honors Scholarships Offered
- Offers Four Years of Honors Academies Opportunities
- Facilitate Cross-Disciplinary Studies
- Honors Residential Opportunities
- Typically Smaller Classes
- Priority Registration for Classes
- Has Control Over Politics, Curriculum, and Faculty
- At least 20% of Students Degree Program
